This allpurpose, center-console, day-cruiser offers the perfect mix of elegant traditional styling with eco-friendly innovation. That is, the vessel is powered by Torqeedo's Deep Blue 100 kW electric inboard motor and two lithium batteries with BMW technology (i3-type). Torqeedo, based in Gilching, Germany, is a market leader for electric mobility on the water. Owners can cruise silently at 6 miles per hour for more than 10 hours. At its top speed of nearly 30 miles per hour the Frauscher 740 Mirage Air has a range of 20 miles.

"While Frauscher hasn't delivered a 740 Mirage Air to the Caribbean yet, we are positive that the boat will perform great in those conditions. The whole electrical installation is salt-water approved and the sophisticated cooling solution takes care of the boat's performance even in very hot conditions. The hull



of the 740 Mirage Air (which is derived from the 747 Mirage Air power boat) has proven its seaworthiness repeatedly in rough conditions," says Florian Helmberger, Frauscher's head of sales and marketing.

#### GRACE SHOWS USVI'S MY BROTHER'S WORKSHOP MARINE PROGRAM IS WELL AFLOAT

When a rowboat named Grace was launched in July, it was a tangible sign of success for the My Brothers Workshop (MBW) Marine program. MBW, an organization started in 2007 to provide income-earning vocational skills to troubled teens and twenty-somethings, added the marine-based component to its program last year. This was possible thanks to a partnership between the nonprofit and the U.S. Virgin Islands' marine community with monies from the Marine Rebuild Fund, which was started in the wake of 2017's major hurricanes.


"The students made templates of half the bottom, one side, and both transoms after taking measurements from the mangled fiberglass pram that trainer Stan Lorbach salvaged years ago. Grace was constructed using the 'stitch & glue' method, which involves tying each piece to one another using 8-inch 'stitches' of thin, galvanized wire and 'glued' with two-part epoxy. This is generally considered one of the simplest methods of building a small boat, which is why MBW chose it as the method for their first project. As the students' skills develop, increasingly complex construction methods as well as larger, more sophisticated boats will be built," explains Jenny Hawkes, MBW's executive director.

Grace's overall length is 7'9", with a beam of 46", and a 7"draft. The hull is formed from 3/8" marine-grade plywood with the rest either white oak, green heart, poplar, or western red cedar. The students also crafted 8' oars made of white oak and western red cedar. The construction took about 7 months. mybrothersworkshop.org

#### NEW STUDY SHOWS MINIMAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT FROM COMMERCIAL AQUACULTURE

The need to feed a burgeoning world population points to seafood as a key resource. Good news is that a study conducted off Panama's Caribbean coast to evaluate the impacts of organic and inorganic pollution from offshore fish farming, one of the major concerns raised in relation to commercial aquaculture production, found minimal environmental impact. This is the first report of its kind from a commercially scaled aquaculture facility that utilized offshore submersible cage technologies. The farm studied houses 22 prism-shaped cages 8 miles offshore in waters from 180 to 210 feet deep. It produces more than 1,500 tons of fish per year.

"Several Caribbean countries exhibit enormous potential for offshore aquaculture. When we look at the map of the Caribbean region, most of what we see is the ocean and rather than competing for limited space on land and distal waters, that's where we think seafood production should take place.



But we must be careful not to go into low energy sites and coastal waters to avoid any activity that could be detrimental to the environment and compete with fisheries. Properly developed aquaculture will benefit the next generations of fishermen and consumers," says Daniel Benetti, professor and director of aquaculture at the University of Miami Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science, in Miami, FL. www.rsmas.miami.edu/index.html

#### SEPTEMBER 14 - 20: SUNFISH WORLD CHAMPI-ONSHIP: SEPTEMBER 21 - 25: SUNFISH YOUTH & MASTER WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP. Over 70 sailors from around the world will compete in the waters off Kralendijk, Bonaire, in these annual one-design championships. The World Championships feature some of the class' best sailors in the world, while the Youth and Master event welcomes several categories of racers ages under 19 and 40-plus. Major sponsor Maclaren will bring in 72 new boats, sails and dollies to assure each competitor has identical equipment and thus a level the playing field.

"The boats will launch from the beach at event venue, Plaza Beach Resort," says Pam Teitel, organizer and member of the host Bonaire Sailing Club as well as manager at Budget Marine Bonaire. "The competition is in the bay directly in front, which means basically no transit times to and from the course. There will be viewing areas to watch the competition both at the resort and from along the shores. The sunfish will be available for sale after the event for a great price, so if you are thinking about buying a boat, September is the time!"



# ZEN & THE ART OF MARINE DIESEL MAINTENANCE

SAILING HUMOR BY CAP'N FATTY GOODLANDER



fter forty plus years as a marine columnist, I must admit that I still get a sadist thrill out of poking fun at powerboaters. I mean—if we inkslinging stick-Noaters can't berate stinkpotters, what good is the literary life? However, there is one thing (besides spending money) that marine motorheads do better than ragmen and that is maintaining their inboard diesel.

Sailboaters have a tendency to pray—which isn't terribly effective.

"If it's not broken, don't fix it," is a good idea. But the concept is carried too far if it results in "If it's about to break in safe harbor, ignore it so it can break at sea and put you, your crew, and your vessel at risk."

First off, I should tell you that I do not consider myself much of a mechanic. However, my lifelong poverty has compelled me to tear apart many an engine—enough of them to confidently state that putting them back together is the hard part! (Especially if you are anal and want to use the same number of parts.)

One good way of thinking about marine diesel maintenance is in terms of problem-solving. Life is full of problems—how to snuggle up to the opposite sex, how to manage to be in the barroom's toilet when the check arrives, how to fib to the taxman, etc.

A successful businessman is just a problem-solver with an easy way to keep score. And here's the bottom line on diesel maintenance: Your engine will run many years far more reliably and cheaply if you do just a few simple things.

"If it's not broken, don't fix it," is a good idea. But the concept is carried too far if it results in "If it's about to break in safe harbor, ignore it so it can break at sea and put you, your crew, and your vessel at risk."

Here are those things.

ONE: Read the manual. I recently purchased (seven blissful years ago) a new Perkins M92B from Parts and Power in Tortola. I not only read the manual, I purchased a digital parts list and the rebuild manual as well.

TWO: Talk to the peeps who, day in and day out, work on these engines. Nothing is perfect. Chances are, all the stuff that's gonna happen to your engine has already happened to its brothers and sisters—and their 'diesel doc' knows. Ask.

THREE: Before you crank up a diesel, check its fluids—especially its lubricating oil. Most boaters don't do this saying— "Hey, I don't get under the hood of my car each time I turn the key—shouldn't my marine diesel be even more dependable?" I repeat: check your oil every time.

FOUR: Once the engine cranks up, watch the exhaust for a couple of minutes to make sure that you have cooling water and to observe the quality of its flow.



NOTE: the exhaust gas should be clear once the engine is up to temperature in the Caribbean—white, constant black, and intermittent black smoke during acceleration all point to different problems.

There are only two common things that happen to a modern diesel that will ruin them forever—running them without oil or running them too hot. You CAN NOT do this. Ever. For any reason. One second is too long. If you have no oil pressure or the engine is too hot, shut it down instantly. Any thought of "I'm only three seconds from my dock!" is an expensive one.

reason. One second is too long. If you have no oil pressure or the engine is too hot, shut it down instantly. Any thought of "I'm only three seconds from my dock!" is an expensive one.

Now the reason that you HAVE to do #3 and #4 each time is to get in sync with your engine. And the best way to do that is to use your five senses. When you check your oil—really look at it. The level is important, sure, but the rate that it is burning oil is important, too. For instance, if your engine starts using more oil and its exhaust starts smoking at the same time—two important elements are clearly telling you that you have a developing major problem. Engines don't lie. They don't exaggerate. They always tell the truth. And 99% percent of the time, they will begin telling you the truth long before there's a major, time-consuming, expensive problem. Thus, cruisers with limited budgets have no choice but to be more proactive maintenance-wise than their wealthier counterparts.

Back to #3: look at the oil. If it looks like honey, great. The blacker it is (assuming proper oil and filter changes), the more micro bits of metal, salt, and abrasives are floating within. If it is *suddenly* black, why? Any sudden change should be noted—and highly suspect. Touch the dipstick with your thumb and forefinger to take a sample—and rub them together.

Good oil, as mentioned, is smooth as honey. If suddenly your oil feels gritty or sandy—that's a major clue disaster awaits.

Yes, you can send it off to a scientific lab for a fuller, most costly analysis—but this is the first step.

If your oil level ever rises—yes, I've had this happen—something bad is leaking into your crankcase. If your oil looks milky—that's usually water leaking in through the cooling system via a head gasket, heat exchanger (check zinc), or oil cooler.

Any engine change should be noted and considered—a change in sound, for example. Or odor. (Rubber smells as temperature increases.)

Here's a sad but important truth: engines don't fix themselves.

The fifth thing I want you to do is widen the aperture of your view to include your engine compartment, engine beds, and bilges. Example: Check the walls of your compartment in the fore area of the engine in both natural and bright artificial light. You might find an area of shading in one area in a circle around the front of your engine. This is the bits of rubber be-

ing thrown from your ever-wearing fan belt. While some wear is normal, if this wear appears to accelerate, immediately replace your belt(s).

Check the engine beds as well. Is one of your engine mounts corroding faster than the other? If so, why? On the engine itself, look for staining, rusting, and/or corroding. Gaskets often fail a molecule at a time, and it is far better/cheaper to fix the problem now, before the engine overheats, than later.

If you are on a monohull with an amidship cockpit and you sail offshore—your engine will be getting wet from above via your steering pedestal leaks. This can be a vexing problem. I have a plywood watershed under my pedestal to shunt water into the bilge rather than pool on my engine, which has dissimilar metals and electro components.

Once a month, I wipe down my engine and trany (always feel under the trany for rear-seal leaks due to misalignment) with an oily rag to get in sync with them. Modern diesels will practically run forever—if their owners gives them a bit of love and attention. (end) Editor's note: the Goodlanders just spend six months in NZ and three in New Caledonia—and are currently entering the Torres Straits.

## SAILING WITH CHARLIE: BER SUPPLI

o you've decided to quit the rat race. You've found the perfect boat, good rig, sails, engine, instruments and ground tackle. You're almost ready to depart for that first exciting voyage but you have no idea how to provision the boat. Neither does your partner, who is a 'takeout' fanatic.

Charlie has a few words of helpful advice. If you have a fridge, don't rely on it. In the tropical latitudes some of the most nutritious foods are root vegetables - and they last for weeks. Yams, sweet potatoes, cassava, yuca (no not yucky, but delicious if cooked properly) and tannia. There are others too. Squash with a hard skin, like pumpkin and butternut squash will last for ages. Some roots like cassava can be waxed to prolong their shelf life.

Eggs are great protein and provide much needed cholesterol - these can be varnished to prevent air getting in and will last for many weeks. Fish and meats can be sliced thin, soaked in vinegar and spices and hung up in the rigging on a sunny day to dry out, rather like biltong, which you can buy ready-made Onions, carrots and garlic will last for weeks too if you pick the right ones, hang them in a hammock and make sure they can't bang into anything when swinging. Rotate them once in a while too, of course.

Citrus fruit lasts a long time especially that vitamin C essential, limes... right limeys? Bananas and plantains keep well if picked green. Vitamin C, the cure for scurvy, was found to be abundant in cabbage by world famous navigator/explorer Captain James Cook. Buy jars of it at the grocery store or if you have time make it yourself - it's easy. Dried fruit, nuts and granola bars should be stored aplenty.

It's amazing how many charter boat visitors don't have a clue on provisioning - even for a week. If they allow for three dinners out and a continental type breakfast daily it should be a cake walk (pun not to be taken seriously!).

Cans and jars are always necessary. Beans of all kinds are a great source of protein as well as canned tuna, sardines, and salmon. A couple of gallons of olive oil, vinegar and other spices and condiments. Charlie always stocks up with a couple of cases of wine- ahem- mostly for cooking of course - I think it was a French gastronome who said, 'A meal without wine is like a day without sunshine.' Don't forget a few gallons of water for emergencies.

Now all you have to do is prepare a menu for a week and rotate it if your voyage is likely to take a month. It's amazing how many charter boat visitors don't have a clue on provisioning - even for a week. If they allow for three dinners out and a continental type breakfast daily – it should be a cake walk (pun not to be taken seriously!).

BTW, fishing equipment should be carefully considered. A 15lb tuna will really add to your larder; cook it immediately and it will keep for several days and is good hot or cold.

When all is said and done, more is said than done!

We're "Back in the B.V.I."

#### YELLOW SUBMARINE (NOT)

Next tune, halfway across Drake Passage, strikes me funny even as I'm belting out those words.

"We all live in a Bali four-point-oh."

For our trusty steed, a Bali 4.0, "Parmenide" by name, is no rickety submersible but an elegant and comfortable catamaran unique to the Dream Yacht Charter fleet.

"And you? Adam, Nicole?"


"We love it. We love you."



# 2019 CARIBBEAN BOATYARD UPDATE

here there are boats, there are boatyards. Given that the Caribbean islands are surrounded by water, and that everything from power to sail, mini to mega, multi and mono plies these waters for transportation, professions and recreation, it makes sense the region's yards are some of the best in the world. Here's a sampling of what's new at several yards.

**DOMINICAN REPUBLIC.** In February, the **IBC Shipyard** at Marina Casa de Campo in La Romana took delivery of a new 300-ton marine lift capable of hauling vessels up to 165' LOA and catamarans with a 36' beam. 





# 10 TOP SPOTS TO BIRD WATCH IN THE CARIBBEAN

BY CAROL M. BAREUTHER



f you want to see birds, from fast-flitting hummingbirds to tropical favorites such as parrots and toucans, then head south. Internationally read Reader's Digest magazine named the Caribbean islands of Trinidad & Tobago, Dominica, St. Maarten/St. Martin and Aruba among the best tropical destinations for bird watchers. These islands are not alone. Virtually every island in the Caribbean boasts an ideal spot to bird watch. Here are our 10-top sampling:

## 1. SIERRA DE BAHORUCO NATIONAL PARK, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC.

Hiking on marked trails through this mountainous park, part of the Jaragua-Bahoruco-Enriquillo UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, is the best way to see over 100 bird species. These include the endangered Hispaniolan parrot, Antillean Piculet, La Selle Thrush, Eastern Chat-Tanager and White-winged Crossbill. The park is 140 miles west of Santo Domingo. www.godominican republic.com



## 2. VIRGIN ISLANDS NATIONAL PARK (VINP), ST. JOHN, U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS.

Smooth billed Ani, Scaly-naped Pigeons and Green Throated Carib hummingbirds are a few of the nearly 150 bird species to see in this park, which occupies approximately 60 percent of the island. Of the over 20 hiking trails, those at Reef Bay, Salt Pond Bay and Francis Bay are best for birding. Additionally, VINP rangers lead a 'Discover Bird Watching Hike' at Francis Bay every Friday starting at 7:30 a.m. www.nps.gov/viis/index.htm





## 3. FLAMINGO POND, ANEGADA, **BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS.**

See flocks of the tall, spindly-legged, pink feathered Caribbean Flamingo on the flattest and eastern-most of the BVIs. A fixture from the early 1800's, a market for the bird's edible flesh and fashionable feathers almost made them extinct. Officials re-introduced the bird in the early 1990's and today it's possible to see them via binoculars or the naked eye from the roadway or water. Billionaire UK businessman Richard Branson, who owns neighboring Necker and Mosquito islands, have helped flamingos thrive by introducing them to these islands too. www.bvitourism.com/anegada





## 4. SALINES D'ORIENT, ST. MARTIN.

This large wetland area, located between Orient Bay and Le Galion, is made up of a large salt pond and several smaller ones. Year-round residents include egrets, herons and black-necked stilts, while migratory shorebird species include whimbrels, willets, sandpipers and plovers. In the surrounding mangroves, there are also yellow warblers, Caribbean elaenias and mangrove cuckoos. Nearby, the Amuseum Naturalis is a good place to learn about local birds. It reopens for the season in October and is open Tuesday-Saturday, 9 a.m.-Noon. www.lesfruitsdemer.com



## 5. FRIGATE BIRD COLONY, BARBUDA.

Antigua's sister island is only 61 square miles in size, but its home to the largest frigate bird colony in the Western Hemisphere. See many of these black feathered critters via a tour of the Codrington Lagoon National Park aboard small power boats with a licensed guides that depart from the Codrington pier. The males especially, with their bright red throat pouches, stand out amazingly from the dense green of the

mangroves in which they roost. Mating season, from September to April, is the best time to visit. www.environment.gov. ag/parks-protected-areas#Codrington-Lagoon-National-Park



## 6. SOUTH SOUFRIERE HILLS. MONTSERRAT.

These plus Centre Hills are the best place to spot the island's national bird: the Montserrat Oriel. It's certainly a bird to see since between hurricanes and volcanic eruptions its population has dwindled to a scant 500 to 800. Look for a medi-

um-sized bird; males are black and yellow in color, while females and young males are yellowish green. Other rare bird species in the Centre Hills area are the Montserrat Galliwasp, the Forest Thrush and Yellow-shouldered Bat, www.visitmontserrat.com







## 7. MORNE TROIS PITONS AND MORNE DIABLOTIN NATIONAL PARKS, DOMINICA.


The rainforest around these two parks, and the mile-long Syndicate Nature Trail and Parrot Preserve on the western slopes of Morne Diablotin, are the best places to see Dominica's national bird: the Sisserou Parrot. Also known as Amazona imperialis, this somewhat scarce parrot is recognizable by its vibrant green back and wings and red streak on its wingtips. There are over 170 other bird species to see here too. discoverdominica.com/en/places/163/syndicate-nature-trail-and-parrot-preserve

## 8. ASA WRIGHT NATURE CENTRE, TRINIDAD & TOBAGO.

Located in Trinidad's Northern Range mountains at 1,200 feet elevation and seven miles from the town of Arima, this non-profit, world-class natural history destination is home to some 400 birds including Squirrel Cuckoos, Tufted Coquettes and a very special breeding colony of the nocturnal Oilbird. Take a 1.5-hour tour, either at 10:30 a.m. or 1:30 p.m., with a professional naturalist guide. There's a restaurant on site. Bring a bathing suit for a dip in the waterfall-fed Clearwater Pool. Asawright.org







#### 9. LITTLE TOBAGO, TRINIDAD & TOBAGO.

Boats, many of which are glass-bottomed, depart regularly from the dock in Speyside, Tobago, to this 450acre uninhabited island. Over a century ago, British publisher and politician, Sir William Ingram, bought the island and brought in a colony of Birds of Paradise from New Guinea to protect them from the plume trade. Unfortunately, they were wiped out in a hurricane in the 1960s. Today, more than 50 bird species, including Audubon's Shearwater, Brown Boobies and Red-billed Tropicbirds either live or next here. www. discover-tt.com/tobago/littletobago.html

## 10. BUBALI BIRD SANCTUARY, ARUBA.

Climb to the top of the 16-foot high observation tower to see more than 80 species of migratory birds. These include Caribbean Coot, Common Moorhen, Pied-billed Grebe, Blue-winged Teal, Purple Gallinule and more. This birds-eye viewing spot, which overlooks both resting and breeding areas, is 6 miles north of Oranjestad, off a dirt road across from the Old Dutch Windmill near the Divi Aruba Phoenix Beach Resort. www.arubabirds. com/aboutbirds/bubalibirdsanctuary.htm







t takes about an hour to cross the St. Lucia Channel, the 21-nautical mile stretch of water that separates the northern end of St. Lucia and southern end of Martinique. Not so by kayak. In fact, it took USA native and Dominica resident, Wes Moses, 6 hours and 59-minute to paddle. Moses, a water sports enthusiast, isn't the first to accomplish this feat. Since 1978, a single kayaker and two teams of double kayakers have paddled the channel as part of much longer Caribbean-long expeditions. Moses, however, is the first and only person to solo cross specifically this channel as documented by the St. Lucia Channel Association, which launched its inaugural swim event last year. With his newfound notoriety, Moses hopes to make sea kayaking in the Caribbean as popular as other watersports such as sailing, sportfishing and scuba diving.

"I first moved to the Caribbean in 1997 as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Jamaica where I served in Trelawny working with the youth in the community. My love of water sports started with swimming and then sailing. This was followed by open water swimming, freediving and sea kayaking," says Moses, who now owns a guesthouse in Soufriere.

The idea for his marine feat started last May when Moses paddled next to Molly Nance as support during the first few hours of Nance's successful swim across the same channel. A







subsequent back injury prevented him from attempting the long-distance paddle last year. Instead, Moses set his sights on kayaking the channel as part of the 2019 St. Lucia Channel Swim, on July 7, where there was safety and support crew.

In preparation, DHF Kayaking in St. Lucia provided him with a Wilderness Systems Tempest 170 kayak and lent him two carbon fiber paddles for the long crossing. On the small deck, Moses placed essentials like 6 liters of water, a waterproof GPS, paddle float, bilge pump and snacks in a waterproof bag. Inside the kayak was more food, additional water, clean clothes, another VHF radio, first aid kit, bilge pump, and spare waterproof bags. Finally, and most importantly, he wore a life

jacket and this he equipped with a VHF Radio, cell phone, knife and energy bars.

"I felt strong and confident the majority of the crossing until the last two and a half hours. The wind was wrapping around Martinique and meeting me head on as I approached the designated landing zone. It slowed my forward progress significantly. It was demoralizing at times. Using land markers, I was able to determine forward movement despite how slow it was. In hindsight, I would have left earlier to beat the winds building up throughout the day and I would have paddled further east along the St Lucian coast before heading north," he says.

Moses arrived close to Anse Meunier beach in Martinique at 12:30 p.m., after leaving St. Lucia at 5:31 a.m. He was a bit wobbly at first. In fact, his legs gave out the minute he reached land causing his paddle, water bottles and food to fall into the surf. Twenty minutes later, he was back on his feet, gathering up his belongings and shaking the sand out of everything.

"I immediately wanted to let the support team know that I had arrived safely. Unfortunately, my phone would not roam in Martinique despite working in the past. Therefore, I had







to borrow a phone from some tourists to send WhatsApp messages which eventually went through. In one respect, it felt like any Sunday afternoon in the Caribbean with reggae and dancehall playing down the beach. In another, how do you explain to people like the tourists that you just paddled over from the island in the distance? It seemed surreal but so real," he says.

Next up, Moses is planning for a crossing of the 22-nautical mile Martinique Passage, from Dominica to Martinique, as well as a circumnavigation of Dominica.

"My recent crossing and subsequent press will hopefully raise awareness of what can be done in a sea kayak," he says. "There is so much potential for the expansion of sea kayaking in the Caribbean."

## RUM BY CLINT AND TERRY BORAM

ne of our favorite rums is Papa's Pilar 24 Dark Rum for its vanilla and honey nose, bourbonlike notes and texture on the palate, and a finish that satisfies our souls. We knew the Hemingway Rum Company had a Blonde but being sipping rum kinda folks, we never considered a taste test. We were in Key West during Hemingway's special release of the Lost Cask Blonde. Hummm...there must be something to this Blonde.

Tricia Flannigan, director of operations and marketing for Hemingway Rum Company, graciously met with us to talk about what made Papa's Blonde different from other silvers on the market. Then, to get a clear picture of the process, we took one of the daily tours available to the public. Our guide, Captain Kirk (everyone at Papa's has a nickname), led us on a fun and informative tour featuring rare photos of Hemingway, fun facts about rum and of course the production facility.

Papa's rums begin with fresh Florida sugarcane to make molasses for use in fermentation. During the distillation process Hemingway's rum makers use their nose rather than technology to tell them when the rum is ready. Unlike many producer's over distilled and odorless rum, Papa's "high wine" has a sweet nose prior to aging. Papa's Blonde is aged for one to seven years in Kentucky bourbon and sherry barrels, then using the solera method, blended using six different rums. Hemingway adds no sugar, coloring or flavoring to its rums.

### **PAPA'S PILAR BLONDE 7**

The nose has a wonderful vanilla note that engulfs our senses. On the palate the vanilla becomes buttery bringing back memories of butterscotch hard candies we had as kids. The finish is smooth and satisfying. Further sips bring out hints of orange and even a bit of almond.

This rum definitely stands on its own as a sipping rum but also makes a wonderful mixer. Pour the Blonde over frozen cubes of coconut water. The hint of coconut added to the vanilla notes makes this a refreshing poolside cocktail.

To be a true Key Wester, mix equal parts of Papa's Blond and Dark. The combination is better than any cocktail we've had this side of the Caribbean. The vanilla leaning Blonde blends



well with the bourbon forward Dark quickly becoming our new favorite cocktail.

eptember in the Caribbean is a month of quiet and change. Even the winds settle down (when there isn't a storm). Perfect time to adjust the menu to foods that are light and refreshing.

#### **GRILLED STUFFED TROUT WITH ASPARAGUS**

Prep time: 10 minutes. Cooking time: 10 minutes. Serves: 4 2 whole trout fish, cleaned Olive oil Fresh ground sea salt, to taste Fresh ground black pepper, to taste 1 small lemon, thinly sliced ½ sweet onion, peeled and thinly sliced 2 cloves garlic, minced 2 sprigs fresh parsley, chopped

Preheat a grill to high heat. Lightly oil the grate. Rub each trout generously with olive oil and sprinkle with sea salt. Open trout and sprinkle inside of cavities with salt and pepper; sprinkle with garlic. Divide lemon and onion slices and place half in each cavity. Sprinkle with parsley. Close trout.

Turn grill down to low and place trout directly on the grill grate; cook about 5 minutes per side, flipping once. Remove to heated serving plate.

#### **RAW CHOCOLATE PUDDING**

Prep time: 1 hour 10 minutes. Serves 4 1 avocado peeled pitted and chopped 1 banana peeled and chopped 1 cup unsweetened almond milk 1/4 cup raw cocoa powder

2 Tbsp agave nectar

1 tsp fresh lemon juice

1/4 cup unsweetedned coconut

#### **KALE SALAD**

Prep time: 15 minutes 1/4 cup rice vinegar 1 tablespoon orange juice 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard 1 teaspoon grated orange zest 1 teaspoon ground cumin 1/4 teaspoon red pepper flakes 1/3 cup olive oil

salt & ground black pepper to taste 1 bunch kale 1 persimmon, sliced 1 apple, cut into matchsticks 2 orange, peeled & cut into segments (see footnote) 1/4 cup chopped pistachio nuts

Whisk vinegar, orange juice, Dijon mustard, orange zest, cumin, and red pepper flakes together in a bowl. Slowly pour olive oil into the orange juice mixture, whisking until thick and thoroughly combined. Season dressing with salt and black pepper.

Remove stems from each leaf of kale. Stack 3 to 4 leaves of kale and roll together. Finely slice kale leaves crosswise to create thin ribbons.

Combine sliced kale, persimmon, apple, orange, and pistachio nuts in a bowl. Add dressing and toss until well coated.
