#### **INVINCIBLE ANNOUNCES NEW 33' CATAMARAN MODEL, HULL ONE EXPECTED IN SPRING 2021**

Known for over a decade for its premium saltwater sport fishing and high-performance boats, the Invincible Boat Company recently unveiled its new 33' catamaran with hull number one expected to be completed by Spring 2021. This will be the fifth catamaran model offered by the Opa-locka, FL-headquartered company, whose portfolio includes ten semi-custom monohulls and multihulls from 33' to 46'. The 33' boasts a comfortable 10' beam, 400-gallon fuel capacity and dedicated twin-outboard power with 900 horsepower.

"Our catamarans provide excellent seakeeping in a variety of conditions, designed from the outset to cope with tough states of sea whilst providing a soft dry ride," says Ian Birdsall, Invincible's vice president of international business. "Our Morrelli and Melvin designed asymmetric hull also endows our boats with excellent handling in following seas, not something other Catamarans are especially good at. The range can also be an important consideration when, say traveling between islands, our 35' for example has a sweet spot around 45 mph where you will get better than 500 miles range. That's an unusually high cruise speed for any boat in this category and can be a big advantage when avoiding weather. Of course, once you get to your destination, the stability at rest or anchor, together with the huge interior volume, makes for a fantastic fishing and socializing platform.



# THE BEST OF THE PAST, THE HOPE OF FUTURE

SAILING HUMOR BY CAP'N FATTY GOODLANDER



fter over 60 years of living aboard, I'm often asked by lubber and sailor alike, "What's your favorite island?"

In order to answer, I have to rephrase the question in my head, "Which is the island where you've enjoyed the most magic?"

I believe that we all carry a little transitory magic inside us and that the places we visit also flood and ebb with a similar magic. When our magic cycles happen to be in sync with our destination, the magic lifts us like a tsunami of good vibes. And I believe that part of this magic is generational—that Haight Ashbury really was a cool place during the 1967 Summer of Love. (Good rule of thumb—if you've heard a place has the magic, the magic has already moved on.)

Example: I've never been in Key Wasted when it had the magic but I've talked with hundreds of people who werewho can regale you with stories of Ernest Hemingway, Judy Blume, Shel Silverstein, Tennessee Williams, and Jimmy Buffett all shooting craps in the toilet of the Green Parrot—as artist David Wegman was hustling pictures of A Frig'n Queen to the tourists at sunset and while marine author Carole Borges was hawking copies of her Dreamseeker's Daughter from the deck of Ms. Bligh.

...they were all in the right place at the right time—not, alas, I. However, I've had my Caribbean moments—for instance, on St. Barts, St. John, and Bequia in the 1970s. Turks and Caicos was pretty darn cool back when they only allowed drug smugglers in. In the States; New Orleans, Miami. St. Augy, and San Francisco Bay all shined for a while. Ditto, numerous places in Winyah Bay, the Chesapeake, Newport, and the Gulf of Maine all flashed on and off.

I've never been in Key Wasted when it had the magic but I've talked with hundreds of people who were who can regale you with stories of Ernest Hemingway, Judy Blume, Shel Silverstein, Tennessee Williams, and Jimmy Buffett all shooting craps in the toilet of the Green Parrot.

I'll never forget owning numerous businesses in Fort Liquordale when it was hemorrhaging so much money that even a fool such as I was able to earn some. (Yes, it was a swell time to be in the marine industry of South Florida—if you didn't get hit in the head by some falling burlap seafood or spin the prop of your dinghy by running over a square grouper.)

For a while now I've been following the exploits of the traditional sailors of Port Townsend—not to mention all my Alaskan friends who are currently cruising.

Even French Polynesia can still be cool if you spend most of your 90 days in the Marquesas and Tuamotus. Huahine was the highlight of our 2018 tour. Manuae, the western most of the Society's is super-cool as well. While I love all of Tonga, the Ha'apai group is still almost untouched by time—as are some of the northern Cook Isles. Fiji is fine if you don't mind kava-ing up. We've spent six summer seasons in New Zealand—the smartest cruising destination with the highest quality of life that speaks English, in our humble opinion.

Currently, our favorite ocean is the Indian—very little has changed on Cocos Keeling and Rodrigues in the last hundred years... maybe a goat got pregnant?

They still openly speak to their dead in Madagascar. If they have bad luck, they unbury their relatives, clean off their bones with toothbrushes, decorate them with ribbons, and rebury them for another decade of relative peace.

Santa calls to a passing waitress. 'Drinks are on me, everyone. Ho ho ho, He he he... Merry, merry..."








ocation is everything. While not as recognized for cruising as the Leeward Islands like the Virgins, St. Maarten/St. Martin and Antigua, or the Windwards such as St. Vincent and the Grenadines and Grenada, the southernmost Netherlands Antilles or ABC islands - Aruba, Bonaire and Curacao, have the advantage of lying south of the hurricane belt. That's huge, especially when it comes to late summer and fall cruising. Also, taking the course less cruised opens the door to experiencing a whole other world of the Caribbean. It's no wonder that Curacao especially, located 56 miles west of Bonaire and 74 miles to the east of Aruba, is especially becoming a popular destination for cruising and chartered yachts alike. One of many reasons is that Curacao is the largest of the ABC islands and thus has much to offer.

"Given Curação's natural harbors and ideal location outside of the hurricane belt, it's no wonder the island has become somewhat of a Mecca for boating enthusiasts in the Caribbean. With over 35 captivating cove-like beaches varying from untamed coast to tranquil inlets, there's plenty to explore by boat," says Raul Manotas, chief communications officer for the Curação Ports Authority. "Plus, From Willemstad's marinas, boaters can enjoy Otrobanda's street art, shops and restaurants, the engineering marvel that is the Queen Emma Bridge, Punda's colored European architecture, and Plasa Bieu, a market serving local dishes like arepa di pampuna and keshi yenà. Then from exploring the white sand beaches and world-class diving and snorkeling to venturing into the Hato Caves or climbing Mr. Christoffel, there are several fun days all at yachtsmen's' fingertips."







#### **MARINA & MARINE FACILITIES**

There are two main ports, Willemstad and Spanish Waters, where boaters can find supplies, complete repairs, and locate a wide range of facilities and services. In Willemstad, the island's capital city and main port, it may be possible to dock at Handelskade or Mathey Wharf, but this depends on permission from the harbormaster. Anchoring here, too, requires an official okay, and there is a charge to do so. This area, around Willemstad's huge natural Schottegat harbor - the largest in the Caribbean, is home to the Curação Marine. In 2021, Curação Marine is set to expand its slips from 40 to 62. The company also offers 140-plus dry berths, a variety of repair services and the ability to do slipway towing with its 60-ton hydraulic Roodberg trailer.

Six nautical miles to the southeast is Spanish Water, a large, protected bay. Because there's less commercial traffic here, many like to dock here and go by car or taxi to clear customs



in Willemstad. Spanish Water is home to the Curação Yacht Club, where there is fuel available, a bar and restaurant, and dockage with utilities like water and electricity for an added charge. There's also Kima Kalki Marina, which offers dockage for yachts up to 60' LOA with a 9-foot draft or less. The Jan Sofat Marina and Palapa Beach Resort and Marina are associated with residential and resort properties.





"From several locations in Spanish Water there is free daily transport to supermarkets and the Budget Marine chandlery," says Roeland van Bijnen, general manager of the St. Maartenheadquartered chandlery's Curacao location. "Curaçao has an extensive range of shopping options. In general, we are looking forward to welcoming more visiting yachts. The Curacao Cruisers net is on VHF channel 72 starting at 7:30 a.m. On Thursdays, starting at 5 p.m. weekly, there is a cruisers diner and Happy Hour at the Pier (restaurant, located at the end of the Caracasbaaiweg, near the Palapa Beach Resort). This is very well visited, and COVID-19 rules are in place."

North of Willemstad, in Piscadera Bay, Royal Marine Services Curacao offers berths, yard storage, a lift and maintenance and repair services. There's also a fuel dock, restroom and showers, and chandlery.

There are anchorages at several beaches around the island including Santa Cruz, Groot Knip and Playa Forti. Anchorage is also available at the nearby island of Klein Curaçao, a local-favorite spot for uncrowded beaches and excellent snorkeling. Moorings are available at Willemstad and St Michiel's Bay. For overnighting, Willemstad and Spanish Waters are the best, but

Piscadera Bay and St Michiel's Bay offer more secluded options.

#### **SEE & DO**

There's a plan underway to revitalize the waterfront around the Sint Anna Bay area in Willemstad and develop businesses and commerce. The timeline includes upgrading the Arts & Craft District, water quality improvements, mixed-use developments and water quality improvements, along with trails and a zipline.

"The new additions are expected to provide added options for yachting passengers, thus increasing maritime tourism in Curaçao's capital. Plus, the Yachting Cruise Taskforce has prepared a 10-year strategic development plan for the yachting sector on the island, which has been approved by the Government of Curaçao," says the Curaçao Ports Authority's Manotas.

Beyond Willemstad, there are plenty of pristine beaches to explore, scuba diving over wrecks and reefs, and hiking in the Shete Boka National Park. Those looking for a walk on the wild side can tour the Hato Caves or visit the Flamingo Park or Ostrich Farm.

The largest annual yachting event is the annual Blue Marlin Release Tournament, held by the Curação Yacht Club. Be-

yond the fishing tournament, annual regattas include the Sunfish Sail Races, typically held in January. CURsailing, the sailing federation of Curação, has been holding several smaller regattas as recently as October, after holding virtual regattas in the spring. Given the current travel situation with the CO-VID-19 pandemic, regatta dates for 2021 are still to be decided. Yet, thanks to the 'below the hurricane belt' location of Curacao, events can take place at any time of the year.



### CURAÇAO COVID-19 **UPDATE**

The rules for entry by boat are the same as for entry by air - All travelers must complete three steps before their trip:

- Present proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test result taken within 72 hours of traveling
- Complete a Digital Immigration Card at dicardcuracao.com and upload their negative results to the portal
- Fill out a Passenger Locator Card (PLC) online within 48 hours before departure








The channel into Benner Bay is marked with day shapes on pilings with a depth of 8ft at high tide and 7 feet at low tide in the channel. Please call the office for an emailed channel chart but as a rule, favor the red.

#### **Combined Marina Facts**

There is a 93 slip Marina attached to the boatyard, which does long term slip rentals (three months or more). Our sister marina, Compass Point Marina, which has 195 slips, is just South of Independent Boatyard & Marina in Benner Bay bordering the entry channel. Compass Point Marina does do transient slip rental on a space available basis. Both marinas due to their location in a hurricane hole, allow vessels to remain in their slips during the hurricane season provided vessels comply with our written hurricane tie-off plan.

Adjacent to our slipway is a floating staging dock used by vessels slated for haulout.

# IS RUM KETO FRIENDLY?

RUM BY CLINT AND TERRY BORAM



e get asked all the time - aren't you concerned about all that sugar you are pumping into your body when drinking your beloved rum? Sure we are, but not all rums have sugar. Wait...back the bus up. A product derived from sugar is sugar-free? Depends on what rum you choose.

Before we get into this discussion rum cocktails mixed with ginger beer, full leaded soda and fruit juice have sugar. Is rum and diet soda Keto friendly? As you'll see below it depends on the rum. But why would you want to mix perfectly good rum with chemical laden diet soda anyway?

Rum begins with sugar cane which is pressed to extract the water and the sugar juice. Some producers use this sugar cane juice as the base of their rum while others boil the juice further to create either a cane syrup or molasses. The juice, syrup or molasses is combined with water and yeast and fermented for as little as a day to upwards of two weeks. Then Magic! The yeast eats all the sugar leaving the producer with

pure alcohol. The alcohol is then distilled and aged. It's the blending process that can cause some skepticism on whether the rum is truly sugar free. If the producer is going to add sugar or additives, it will be at this time.

Unfortunately, most producers are not forthcoming as to whether they add anything back into the rum during the blending process because...we put simply, they are not regulated by their country to do so. Regulations run the gamut from zero requirements to requiring minimum aging time. Jamaica is one of the few countries where it's illegal to adulterate rum without the permission from the government.

### Hydrometers do not measure the amount of sugar in alcohol rather the change in density from the reported ABV.


How do we find out if we are drinking pure unadulterated rum? There is a tool called a Hydrometer which measures the ABV (alcohol by volume) in a liquid. Hydrometers do not measure the amount of sugar in alcohol rather the change in density from the reported ABV. This change could be from sugar, additives or an inaccurate representation of the reported ABV, though the latter is rare. Readings between 0-5 g/l (grams per liter) are considered to be additive free.

As an example Appleton Estate 21 from Jamaica states an ABV of 43.0 with a Hydrometer reading of 42 equating to 0-5 g/l. Keto friendly. On the other hand Ron Zacapa products, known as the benchmark of fine rum, measures between 20-28 g/l. In fact many of the rums we have reviewed over the years show up on the Hydrometer lists as having higher additives readings.

Confused yet? Here's a simple list. Barbados rums like Foursquare, Mount Gay and Doorly's do not have added sugar. Neither do Appleton, Blackwell or Mezan from Jamaica, as required by law. If you want to mix with diet, Bacardi Superior and Captain Morgan White are Keto friendly. For all other rums check out The Fat Rum Pirate for an extensive Hydrometer list. https://thefatrumpirate.com/hydrometer-tests-2.

#### CARIBBEAN COOKING BY CAP'N JAN ROBINSON

y oh my, what a challenging year this has been. It's time to Celebrate ... the last month of 2020.

One of the perks of hosting Christmas dinner is looking forward to dishes made with your leftover turkey. In the recipes below you can just omit the Turkey, if you prefer to eat vegan!

#### CARROT, KALE, AND WHITE BEAN SOUP WITH TURKEY

Preparation time: 15 minutes. Cooking time: 20 minutes. Serves: 4

1-1/2 Tbsp. coconut oil

2 medium size leeks, chopped fine

3 large carrots, peeled and chopped fine (I do mine in food processor)

1 (15 oz) can white beans, drained and rinsed Leftover pieces of turkey, shredded, optional\*

Freshly ground black pepper, to taste 1 tsp. turmeric powder ½ tsp. coriander Pinch of sea salt 4 cups veggie or bone broth, or water

4 cups of chopped

green and/or red kale

In a large heated frying pan, add oil. Sauté leeks and carrots with turmeric, coriander, black pepper and salt, until a little browned. Add broth, then beans and kale. Bring to a boil, then turn down to a simmer for 15 minutes until carrots and kale cooked to how you like them. Add beans and shredded pieces of turkey for another five minutes or until heated through.

\*NOTE: You may prefer to leave out the turkey and keep your soup vegan. Remove soup from heat and blend all in a food processor or serve as is (chunky). Adjust seasons if necessary. I prefer the latter – chunky!

#### THAI COCONUT CURRIED TURKEY WITH RICE STICK NOODLES

Preparation time: 15 minutes. Cooking time: 20 minutes. Serves: 6

3 cups turkey, chicken or vegetable stock

1 (13-1/2 can) coconut milk

4 cloves garlic, minced

1-inch fresh ginger, finely grated

1 piece fresh lemon grass, prepared and bruised\*

2 tsp Chinese five-spice powder Finely grated zest of 1 lime 2 cups diced cooked turkey

1½ cups green beans, cut in half

1½ cups snap peas, trimmed

1½ cups quartered cremini mushrooms

8 oz. of rice stick noodles, cooked and drained

Salt and black pepper



#### **GARNISH:**

2 cups fresh bean sprouts ½ cup fresh basil leaves 1/4 cup fresh cilantro leaves

1/4 cup chopped peanuts Fresh lime juice and hot sauce, to taste

In a stockpot, place stock, coconut milk, garlic, ginger, lemon grass, five-spice powder, and lime zest. Bring to a simmer over medium heat. Add beans, snap peas, and mushrooms; return to a simmer and cook for about 2 minutes, just until beans are tender. Stir in turkey and season to taste with salt and pepper.

TO SERVE: Rinse the cooked rice noodles in a colander under hot water and divide them between 6 bowls. Ladle the soup into bowls and top with bean sprouts, basil, cilantro and peanuts. Season to taste with lime juice and hot sauce.

NOTE: \* bruised with a meat mallet or rolling pin



# FOOD SAFETY TIPS FOR LEFTOVER TURKEY

#### Q. How long do you have to use leftovers?

Please make sure that you use up the turkey within the first five days if you are going to repurpose your turkey leftovers - if not, put it in freezer bags or in glass containers with lids.

#### Q. How long can you freeze leftover turkey?

Place turkey leftovers (in freezer bags or glass containers with lids) in the freezer up to 3 months or so. Remember to date the packages.

Q. How do I defrost the leftovers? Defrost in the fridge overnight.
