## PROFESSIONAL YACHT CHEF ELIZABETH LEE PUBLISHES NEW COOKBOOK – MADE WITH LOVE: CULINARY INSPIRATIONS FROM AROUND THE WORLD

Learn how to make Italian Sushi, Butter Poached Lobster Tail and Crème Brulee, the latter using the fine French cooking technique of sous vide. This is only the first bite of what you'll find inside professional yacht chef Elizabeth Lee's new cookbook, Made With Love: Culinary Inspirations from Around the World. Written by Lee with 138-gorgeous food and travel photographs by Captain Warren East, the cookbook is divided into four sections: salads, appetizers, entrees and desserts, and contains 163 recipes.

The premise behind this book is to show that the majority of kitchens on yachts, known as galleys, have very limited space. Many of the recipes in my book were developed and executed in these tiny areas, attesting to the fact that gourmet cuisine can be created in the smallest of spaces whether in a yacht, apartment, condo, or home," says Lee, a native of Nova Scotia, Canada, who graduated with honors and a

Culinary Arts degree from the University of the Okanagan in British Columbia, moved to the Caribbean in 2003 and since then won charter yacht culinary competitions in the BVI, Antigua and Turkey. She has also logged over 250,000 miles at sea on yachts to destinations in North America, the Caribbean, Trans-Atlantic, Mediterranean, and the Near East.

Personally, Lee calls the salad recipes in the cookbook her absolute favorite. Beyond that, she is an avid fan of the sous vide style of cooking. This process entails vacuum-sealing food in a bag and cooking it in a water bath to a specific temperature.

"The sous vide recipes also provide traditional cooking methods as well so If you are new to the science of sous vide, I recommended becoming comfortable with the dish using the traditional method and then advancing your techniques and trying the magic of sous vide," Lee says.



Powerboat racing at its best is the perfect way to describe this event, held annually for over a half-century and hosted by the Trinidad & Tobago Powerboat Association. Boats in several different speed classes launch off from the Gulf of Paria in Trinidad, wind their way through the Bocas, then up the island's north coast, round a marker at Grand Riviere, and finish in Store Bay, Tobago. As well as pushing their powered-up machines to the limit, the crewed experience offers totally different water conditions on each leg of the race, which all adds to the keen skill and competition. "This is a very tricky year with COVID delaying planning," says Marcus Gomez, president. "It will likely be a year with no spectators gathering in numbers. We are aiming to live stream the race. We will also be continuing the national records per each racing class that we started last






year. Boats this year have a chance at beating the times set last year." The Great Race became a UIM (Union Internationale Motonautique) sanctioned event in 2018, with an official 80.5-mile world record course set between Trinidad and Tobago. Motul Monster, driven by Trinidad's Joey Sabeeney, was the first boat to set this world record and currently holds the fastest time of 47 minutes and 43 seconds. www.thettpba.com



The only problem is those pesky reefs. The first one he hits at night and it mangles his prop. The second one he hits while distracted by a spilled Pina Colada—hey, sh\*t happens. That one ruins the lower unit and worse—allows his inflatable to



drift onto the coral. His dinghy is destroyed and his legs get cut-up while attempting to fend off.





And sleeping on the beach is out—not with pale-skinned, aggressive Nazis roaming the shoreline in search of prey.



"When dey begin using dere own flippers for de paddle," Red Mon told me later, "dat's always a bad sign, dat's always near de end." (end of story).





y the beginning of August all eyes are turned eastwards; the month is approaching peak hurricane time in the islands with September being the most likely. Many yachts will have already hauled out and hurricanized; others will be prepared to make a run for it if an ominous storm system is heading our way. It takes about three days (150 miles a day) to reach Curacao with all their safe, protected anchorages south of the hurricane belt.

By mid-October, if the plague has subsided, charter boats will be preparing for what will likely be a very busy season. Charlie reckons it's time for locals to step up and take their rightful place as sailors and congenial hosts to waterborne visitors. With all the hi-tech instruments, water makers, electric winches, chart plotters, gen sets and air conditioning it's easy. The big tourist attraction in the BVI has always been yachting. The pay is good (four figure gratuities are not uncommon); the trick is to entertain your guests with stories, history and local titbits of interest.

Make sure you can engage the visitors with interesting anecdotes. For instance, every island in the BVI has a story. From a famous shipwreck (Salt Island) to pirates and buried treasure (Norman Island), Drake's Anchorage in North Sound (Virgin Gorda), the wreckers' island (Anegada), a Quaker island (Little Jost van Dyke) and world famous beach bars (Jost van Dyke), a unique geological beach with granite boulders (The Baths) ... the list goes on. There's enough there for a week of happy hours.


On almost every trip Charlie gets the guestion, 'Are there sharks in these waters?' Of course there are, but it's best to minimize the fact so as not to discourage snorkeling. Mention dolphins and turtles and the high probability of seeing them; the conversation now becomes more relaxed. Have a fish identifier on board and explain some of the wonders of the underworld - sorry, underwater world. 'Can the boat tip over? that's another one, but smile, shake your head and point out all the hundreds of boats sailing around. 'What about pirates?' 'Well, these days all the pirates have turned into smug drugglers and they want to avoid everybody, so no problem.' 'Will we get seasick?' Answer: 'I've never ever been seasick in Caribbean waters.' After a while you can almost feel the relaxation set in.

'Are there sharks in these waters?' Of course there are, but it's best to minimize the fact so as not to discourage snorkeling. Mention dolphins and turtles and the high probability of seeing them; the conversation now becomes more relaxed.

A personal yarn or sea story will add to their perception of you as a true Caribbean hand. Charlie remembers a time in Cuba, at a chintzy Russian prefab hotel near Santiago, when his first mate entered the toilet and a member of staff came running up to her and peeled off two squares of TP and gave it to her. TP was obviously an expensive luxury likely to be stolen if a whole roll was available on display.

If they want to fly a flag of a political leader just say 'No, this is the BVI.'

Oryxx and her Viking crew are now about to embark on a







sailboat's meant to sail, but there are plenty of situations and maneuvers where it's great to have an engine on the boat. Unfortunately the connection between this engine and its propeller requires a big hole in the hull under the waterline with a rotating shaft going through. Inventors and technicians have found different solutions to cope with this challenge over many years. For a long time stuffing boxes were the state-of-the-art technology—simple and safe devices, but


wet bilges were unavoidable. The compression of the shaft packing inside the stuffing box (or stern gland) must be just enough to accomplish a watertight seal when the shaft is stationary so an unattended boat will not sink and to drip slightly when the shaft is turning to lubricate and cool the shaft as well as the packing.

A wet bilge was acceptable on old boats where basically everything from the galley sink to the fridge drain went into











the (smelly) bilge, which would have to be pumped regularly anyway. Standards have changed nowadays and many boat owners want dripless seals so they won't have to deal with such a smelly mess anymore. On a metal boat damp areas are prone to corrosion, so it's even more important than on other boats to keep them dry. Pitufa's aluminum bilge is dry and we want to keep it this way—especially as we use the space for storage.

## **DRIPLESS SEALS**

Dripless shaft seals are based on one of two different principles: lip seals or face seals. Among other manufacturers, Volvo Penta and Vetus offer shaft seals based on lip seals. Usually these have no moving parts and the seal is accomplished by one or more elastic lips around the propeller shaft (also called radial shaft seals or Simmerrings). The lips require regular greasing, which might be a cumbersome and splashy job while the boat is in the water.

Face seals on the other hand are supposed to be maintenance-free. The principle of a face seal is a rotating ring (attached tightly around the shaft) which is pressed against a stationary ring (attached to the stern tube). One ring is made of graphite or carbon (which has a self-lubricating property), the other one from high-quality stainless steel. A very popular shaft seal based on this principle is the PSS from PYI Inc. Here a rubber bellow that is attached to the stern tube acts as a spring to push the stationary carbon ring against the rotating stainless steel collar fixed on the propeller shaft in front.


Of course, rubber fatigues and can become brittle with age, especially in an environment where it is exposed to heat, vibration, saltwater and accidental fuel spills. However, the price of a PSS is rather moderate, so exchanging it regularly won't kill the cruising kitty.

Pitufa's previous owner was German, so she came with





many gadgets 'made in Germany'. One of those is our shaft seal: it's called ProfiSeal (www.profiseal.com) and its design is based on a face seal. Instead of a rather flimsy rubber harmonica, it features a solid metal housing that is flange-mounted to the stern tube. As Pitufa is an aluminum boat, the flange and housing are also made of aluminum the standard version, however, is made of bronze. Inside the housing a rotary unit (fixed to the shaft) consists of a massive stainless steel spring and a graphite ring, which is pressed against the forward end of the housing where a stainless steel ring sits. Like the PSS it has a hose barb for the intake of cooling water. It is very compact, only 11 cm (4.3") long for our 35 mm shaft, making it probably the only face-type option when space is limited.

Our ProfiSeal has kept the boat dry for incredible 23 years (all year cruising in the tropics, mainly under sail) and its endurance against the constant galvanic attacks from a much nobler close-by neighborhood is extraordinary. The standard version, which is made of bronze, lasts probably even longer. We only changed the rotating unit and the stainless counter ring after we had to pull the shaft for repairs six years ago. We contacted the company and were astounded by the swift customer support. Spare parts were available without delay and came with professional advice which helped with the re-installation. By now the aluminum housing shows some corrosion, so we have decided to replace it when we haul out the boat next time—of course we'll install a ProfiSeal again. High quality comes at a slightly higher price, but you definitely get what you pay for and you don't have to worry about maintenance or replacements for a very long time. 0

## FRIGATE RESERVE 15 YEAR OLD

## RUM BY CLINT AND TERRY BORAM

e are liking the new liquor store that opened up in our neighborhood. Their rum stock is so full of undiscovered rums it's hard to decide where to start. This month we were drawn to the bird proudly soaring on the label of the rum. We couldn't wait to soar into the story of Frigate Reserve.

The idea for Frigate began when friends were sitting around a fire in Abaco, Bahamas smoking cigars, sipping rum and reflecting on life. The conversation turned to rum itself and how it was increasingly difficult to separate a good rum from a bad. That night they felt it their job, no their duty, to create a fine sipping rum.

The friend's crusade led them to Panama where they met with Don Pancho Fernandez, best known as the "Cuban Minister of Rum." Pancho produces a classic-leaning style of rum done in the Cuban tradition. After hearing the friend's mission, Pancho opened his Reserves where they began with the 21 year old, blending together thousands of combinations to find the perfect rum. Once perfected, Frigate used the exact recipe to create the 15, 12 and eight year old.

The name Frigate was an easy decision for the friends. The



bird is known as an omen of good fortune to fishermen and spends months in the air over the ocean seeking food and a dry place to land. The friends live their lives in search of uncharted endeavors. Their motto "Live on the Wings" is on every bottle of Frigate Rum.

#### **HE SAID**

This has a very spicy nose with cloves and a slight hint of black pepper. The palate is very smooth with a slow release of different notes. The front of the palate is toasty and nutty with toasted molasses, toasted almond, and the char from the barrels. The spice notes return on the backside of the palate and continue to the finish. For me this presents like a spiced rum. I'm enjoying how it hangs with me for guite a while.

#### **SHE SAID**

The golden color coats the glass but doesn't have a lot of legs. I'm not sure where Clint is getting all this spice from on the nose. Orange, soft baking spices, apple and a slight hint of vanilla fill my senses. The rum has a really nice mouth feel coating the palate like honey without the added sweetness. Once the rum opens up, there is a punch of spice with hot cinnamon candy, cloves and the undertone of apple. Those notes carry to the finish which, for me, doesn't stay nearly as long as Clint's. Actually I enjoy the nose which keeps me there to explore.

### **OVERALL**

Our contradicting reviews speaks to the complexity of Frigate Reserve 15. At \$48/bottle there is something to explore at every turn. One dollar of every bottle sold goes to getting Abaco back on its feet after Dorian.

## LET FOOD BE THY MEDICINE

## CARIBBEAN COOKING BY CAP'N JAN ROBINSON



Turmeric - contains curcumin, a strong anti-inflammatory compound; great for arthritis.

Ginger - contains a key pound called gingerol; another antiinflammatory compound.

**Walnuts** – are great source of omega-3 fatty acids

Dark Leafy Greens - like kale, spinach, and collard greens contain loads of anti-inflammatory compounds, including vitamins C and E and more.

Onions, Garlic, Cauliflower, Broccoli, all the beans, Berries, ground flaxseed; to name a few.

#### **REFRESHING WATERMELON, CANTALOUPE & KIWI SOUP**

Prep time: 5 minutes. Chilling time: 30 minutes or longer

Watermelon Kiwi Fruit Cantaloupe Plain yogurt

Purée watermelon, cantaloupe and kiwi together. Chill for 30 minutes if the fruit is not already chilled. To Serve: swirl in a little plain yogurt and serve.

TIP: Omit yogurt and add vodka; makes a refreshing drink!

### **VEGETARIAN CURRY**

Prep time: 20 minutes. Cooking time: 20 minutes. Makes: 4

3 Tbsp. extra virgin olive oil

1 small yellow onion, peeled and diced

1 small cauliflower, cut in small florets

2 cups broccoli cut in

1 cup of diced carrots

small florets

2 tsp. kosher salt, divided

5 garlic cloves, mined

2 tsp. grated ginger 2 cups vegetable broth 1 Tbsp. curry powder

½ tsp. cumin

1 tsp. turmeric

3 Tbsp. chunky peanut butter, or creamy

1 cup frozen peas, thawed

1 (15 oz.) can chickpeas, drained and rinsed

GARNISH: Chopped cilantro and Mango Chutney (medium or hot)



Heat large skillet and heat oil to medium high, Add the vegetables to the skillet with ½ tsp. kosher salt and cook for 8 minutes, stirring occasionally, until fork tender and lightly browned. Once tender, add the garlic and ginger; cook for another minute. Stir in curry powder, cumin, turmeric, ½ tsp. kosher salt, peanut butter, peas and chickpeas. Stir in vegetable broth. Simme. r for about 10 minutes until the sauce is thickens slightly. Serve.

Serve with: brown rice, white rice, wild rice, quinoa, naan bread or what bread you like. Or you can also place on a Soft Tortilla Wrap (I used Spinach and Herbs); wrap, eat, and enjoy!

HINT: For me, Mango Chutney is a must!

## **QUINOA, PEAS, FETA, MINT SALAD WITH LEMON & CHILI**

Prep time: 20 minutes. Cooking time: 20 minutes. Makes: 4

1/3 cup quinoa, tri color or color of your choice 1/8 cup shredded mint leaves Zest of & juice of ½ lemon ½ small red chili, deseeded and finely chopped 1/3 cup thawed frozen peas 1/3 cup crumbled feta cheese

Put the quinoa in a small saucepan with 2/3 cup of cold water. Bring to the boil over high heat, then reduce heat to low. Cover and simmer for 15 minutes or until soft and fluffy; adding a splash of water if the quinoa starts to dry out.

When the quinoa is cooked, drain well and transfer to a bowl. Gently stir in the mint leaves so they soften a little in the heat. Squeeze over the lemon juice and mix in the chili and the peas. Mix in the feta. Sprinkle over the lemon zest, then season with black pepper.

HINT: For extra nutrients and crunch, stir in some toasted and chopped almonds or walnuts.

TIP: This can be made up to 3 days in advance and stored in a 0 sealed container in the fridge.
