



UNDERWATER SPACE STATION OF THE OCEAN TO BE BUILT OFF CURACAO

What's being called the equivalent of the international space station but built 60 feet under the sea will become a reality in the Caribbean by 2026. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) and the Proteus Ocean Group signed an agreement in May to do just this off Curacao. This underwater state-of-the-art modular underwater habitat, observatory, and research platform, aptly named Proteus, will be a place where scientists and global customers can study marine life, the effects of climate change, and more. The project, featuring the world's most advanced underwater station of its kind, was founded by Fabien Cousteau, grandson of the late ocean exploration pioneer, Jacques Cousteau.

"On Proteus will have unbridled access to the ocean 24/7, making possible long-term studies with continuous human observation and experimentation. With NOAA's collaboration, the discoveries we can make — concerning climate refugia, super corals, life-saving drugs, microenvironmental data tied to climate events, and many others — will be truly groundbreaking. We look forward to sharing those stories with the world," said Cousteau, founder, and chief oceanic explorer of the Proteus Ocean Group.

The nearly 4,000-square-foot Proteus will be built off Fuik, off the southeast coast of Curacao. The Netherlands Antilles island is the favored site for Proteus because of its accessible coral reefs and rich biodiverse marine ecosystems. www.proteusoceangroup.com

ANGUILLA JOINS THE UK'S BLUE BELT MARINE **CONSERVATION PROGRAM**

When a former UK Prime Minister tweets about it, the news must be big. In February, the Government of Anguilla officially became a member of the United Kingdom's Ocean Conservation Program Blue Belt initiative. The Blue Belt initiative supports UK Overseas Territories with the protection and sustainable management of their marine environments. The program especially targets some of the greatest challenges facing the world's oceans today, namely coastal management, biodiversity loss, and plastic pollution. Anguilla's participation in this initiative will help to manage the island's coastal and marine resources to spur economic growth, all while adapting to the effects of climate change.





"We recognize that our most prized assets are our spectacular beaches and turquoise waters. Through the Blue Belt Initiative, we will ensure that they are preserved and promoted so that future generations of both Anguillans and our boating visitors will continue to experience and enjoy them," says Stacey Liburd, director of the Anguilla Tourist Board.

SABA & STATIA MOVE TO SAVE CORAL REEFS

The major new environmental project has a long name: Healthy and Resilient Marine and Coastal Ecosystems Through Reforestation of St Eustatius and Saba. The goal though is short and to the point. That is, to save the coral reefs surrounding these two Netherlands Antilles islands. The plan is to reduce erosion and safeguard the near-shore coral reef ecosystems by reforesting areas stripped bare of vegetation due to land erosion caused by heavy rainfall. This reforestation will in turn slow and redirect water into below-ground aquifers in the denuded areas. It will also restrict the release of sediment onto surrounding coral reefs.

"This will improve the ecosystem services, biodiversity, and economic resilience of Statia and Saba," says Anthony Reid, Statia's director of economy, nature, and infrastructure (ENI).

The over US \$700,000 project is funded by the European Union, through its 11th European Development Fund program, an aid package for African, Caribbean, and Pacific

Successful Season for Grenada's Port Louis Marina

Grenada was named 'Yachting Destination of the Year' for 2023 by Caribbean Journal (CJ), the world's largest website covering the region's travel and trade news. A big reason why is that several nautical events that hosted during the season at Camper Nicholson's Port Louis Marina in St. Georges. "We have seen a huge increase in berth bookings including annual, seasonal, cruisers, catamarans, and superyacht inquiries. It has been a fantastic season, and great to see the marina so full," says Zara Tremlett, CMM, marina manager.

Now the season is calming down, and the global yachting focus moves to the Mediterranean, Tremlett adds that the team at Port Louis Marina is looking forward to taking great care of its annual yachts berthed at the marina. Updating some of the property's facilities is also on the to-do list, as is growing as a marina with some landside developments happening and set to be finished later this year.

Looking ahead, the arrival of the highly anticipated ARC+ yachts will arrive in December, followed by the 10th Anniversary of the RORC Transat, hotly chased by the Pure Grenada Sailing Week 2024 and the Viking Explorers Rally thereafter. FORMER ST. THOMAS SAILOR PENS SAILING NOVEL TITLED *ERIC*



JULY 2-9 | Optimist North American Championships.

Over 130 sailors from 9-plus nations will race out of the Antiqua Yacht Club, with support from the Nelson's Dockyard National Park and English Harbour community for this continental contest. This marks the third time Antiqua has hosted the OptiNams, following successful back-to-back events in 2015 and 2016. We will have new areas to leave dinghies as well as a better marked safe area for swimmers," says Luriel Laboy, a representative of the BVI Tourist Board in Puerto Rico.





JULY 20-23 & JULY 27-30 | Bimini Boating Flings.

Follow the leader and cruise caravan-style 60 nautical miles by boat from South Florida, across the Gulf Stream, to Bimini in the Bahamas. The Bahamas Ministry of Tourist & Aviation sponsors these weekend flotillas which have plenty of unstructured time to fish, swim, snorkel, sight-see, or just relax on the beach. The Captain's Meeting is held on Wednesdays, and the Flings depart on Thursdays from the Bahia Mar Yachting Center in Fort Lauderdale en route to Bimini and return on Sundays. Accommodation for the group is at The Bimini Big Game Club Marina, a 51-room hotel and 75slip marina, which is one of the most popular in the region for boating, yachting, and fishing. There is a 30-boat limit for each Fling and dock space is on a first-come first-served basis. The minimum boat length is 22 feet LOA for the Flings. All vessels must have a valid cruising permit obtained through the initial clearance and entry process. 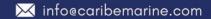
JULY 30-AUGUST 6 | Tour des Yoles.

Set sail or spectate at this iconic nautical competition, one of the biggest in Martinique, that leapfrogs from bay to bay to circumnavigate the island in a week. The focal point is the boat: the yole. These 36-foot-long wood-built vessels have a canoe-like hull, mast made of wood from a single tree trunk, and colorful sails. Crews of 7- to 14-man these sail-boats in often big seas. In 2020, UNESCO officially included the yole in its Intangible Cultural History List. This year, the fleet will leave on Monday, July 31 from Fort-de-France, with stops and big beach-side parties at Le Diamant, Riviere-Pilote, Le Vauclin, Le Francois, Trinite, Saint Pierre, before returning to Fort-de France. tourdesyolesofficiel.com

Except, it is sad to say, when it comes to a boat. A distressing number of liveaboard vessels offer not-a-clue to those folks who inhabit them. Strange!


It is as if the boats somehow intimidate their owners from revealing who they really are.

As the graceful ketch floated and the slings relaxed, the skipper jumped aboard with a can opener in his hand, put a large scratch in the cockpit sole, and said, amid loud, Big Easy cheers, 'now that that's taken care of, welcome aboard!"

Yep, my kind of sailor.

When I sold my Hughes 38 Wild Card after two circumnavigations and 23 years, the new owner negotiated with me to leave as much of the 'art' on the bulkheads as I could.

Ganesh, my current 43-foot Wauquiez ketch, had a factoryfresh interior when I purchased her—and I defaced it ASAP. The last thing I want to do is live in a generic, soulless hotel room—ashore or afloat!

Does this hurt the resale value of a vessel? Perhaps. It might. Or perhaps the potential buyers might realize how much fun the current owners have had aboard... and want to duplicate such an exotic lifestyle.

Isn't a cruising boat the ultimate Movable Feast?

One item I always have aboard is an illuminated, fully-rotating globe which often has the voyages of the schooner Elizabeth, the double-ender Corina, the ketch Carlotta, the sloop Wild Card, and the ketch-with-the-Solent-jibs Ganesh drawn in. (I don't put deliveries or ocean passages I've had on other boats—or the Atlantic, Caribbean, and Pacific would be spider-webbed!)

Of course, pics of our wonderful daughter and our grand kids are on our 'bulkhead of family fame.'

But our most cherished 'artifacts' are cheap items we've retained during our voyages that capture our joy at meeting someone new or being in some special place. Yes, the Bay of Penises in Fatu Hiva is the most beautiful harbor in the world. Sure, the lagoon of Bora Bora will take your breath away. And, of course, Chagos answers every Robinson Crusoe fantasy any sailor has ever had... so why not bring away some small item to forever refresh our happy remembrance? After all, isn't the word souvenir from the French, meaning memory?

Now, my wife and I think nothing of driving nails, screwing





Thus, we use white glue and/or a glue gun to prevent small and delicate items from sliding around in the seaway.

To attach a flattish item to a bulkhead, we carefully pound three or four brass brads into its back. Then we snip off the heads of these brads. Then we put the artifact in its chosen place on the bulkhead—and strike it hard with the heel of our palm. Next, we drill tiny little holes at the marks. This keeps the item in place and even allows it to be removed for varnishing. If we decide to remove the item sometime in the future, we fill the tiny holes with almost anything (wax, stain, glue, sawdust, etc.)

I've done this dozens of times on numerous boats and the tiny holes virtually disappear (if the area isn't in the sun and the artifact fades the varnish).

Of course, double-sided tape works well—especially the 'no

marks' kind that have stretchable webbing embedded in the glue surface that allows the attachment to be broken one tiny cell at a time.

Getting our vessel underway quickly is important to me—as is surviving huge wakes while at anchor. However, that doesn't mean that everything in my boat has to be through-bolted in case of an imminent pitch-poling or 360-degree roll.

When we go for a hard sail, I have to move five items into nearby 'waiting' places. This only takes a couple of seconds and either I or my wife—or our granddaughter crew—can do it.



(Editor's note: Fatty and Carolyn are still on their honeymoon fifty-three years later.)



Top 10 Must-Visit Places in the Grenadines



he Grenadines are a group of islands between St Vincent and Grenada in the Windward Islands and most of the island make up the country of St Vincent and the Grenadines, but the southern few are part of Grenada. From a sailor's perspective this is one of the best locations in the entire Caribbean and I have described it to potential guests as a wilder and more authentic British Virgin Islands with some Bahamas thrown in. With that said, lets jump in as I share my top ten Grenadines islands.

10 Palm Island – If you have been a guest of this private resort then I am sure it will be much higher on your personal list, but the reality is cruisers and charterers are

not allowed to enjoy this beautiful island. There is good snorkeling on the reefs surrounding the island, but the anchorage is rolly and not high on my list of places I want to spend the night.


Canouan Island – I think if this island was elsewhere it would be more sought after, but being in the Grenadines means it comes in at #9. Charlestown Bay offers good protection, but there have been theft issues in the past. The island itself can be broken up into three parts. The northern part is all private communities and you are not allowed to even walk there, the middle stretch is your typical Caribbean village, the southern part is dominated by the airport and marina.




Petite Martinique & St Vincent Islands - These twin islands are a contrast in many ways even though they are separated by half a mile. Petite St Vincent is part of St Vincent and the Grenadines and is one of the most exclusive resorts in the Caribbean, but cruisers are allowed ashore to use the restaurant and bar. Petite Martinique on the other hand is home to a local village and part of Grenada. Smuggling has been a part of the culture on this island for centuries and there is a story of a cop that sailed over to arrest someone, but waited since the entire village was at a funeral. He asked who it was for and they told him it was his funeral. Needless to say he left without the arrest.

Ronde Island - Being the southernmost island it is often overlooked, but there is one anchorage on the leeward side that is wonderful...in settled weather. Ashore you can find watermelon farmers and to the west the Seven Sisters are good for snorkeling. Diamond rock is tall and impressive. Just make sure you are not around if the submerged volcano, Kick 'Em Jenny, three miles away, has any activity.





Mustique Island - Another private island, but this one is accommodating to visiting yachties. This island has many homes owned by famous people. Moorings are available in Britania Bay and I enjoyed the snorkeling in the bay. Ashore you can enjoy the beach, walk through the local's village, take a golf cart tour of the island, and enjoy the local watering hole, Basil's Bar. The only downside is that island access, which does include the mooring, is \$75 whether you use it for one day or three.



Carriacou Island - This is another island of Grenada and the nearby, deserted Sandy Island alone puts this place towards the top of my list. The friendly town of Hillsborough, well protected Tyrrel Bay, and mangrove pond tour just kick it even higher.






Union Island - This is the kite surfing capital of the eastern Caribbean. I personally like using the anchorage at the town of Clifton because of the barrier reef you moor behind, but other cruisers like the quieter Chatham Bay. Ashore I enjoy spending time at the day resort on the north side at Richmond Bay and walking along the ill-conceived marina to get to Frigate Island. But how can you not visit the island on the reef with a guy made out of conch shells called Happy Island? Awesome!



Mayreau Island -One of those places that has nothing, but you spend all day seeing that nothing. Salt Whistle Bay is a wonderful, but crowded anchorage with an amazing beach resort. From here you can walk up the hill to town where everyone seems to want to greet you. The church, and view from it, is well worth the walk up to it. The road will eventually take you down to the other anchorage of Saline Bay.





Bequia Island – One of my favorite islands because of how much such a tiny place packs into it. This island has a whaling past and you can see that in it to this day. The museum is informative and the Whale Bone Restaurant has bar stools made of whale vertebra. Boat building is another past that shows its roots in the present and the model museum is worth a stop. Take selfies with turtles at the turtle sanctuary and during a tour of the Firefly Estate you will try different fruits right off the tree. Finish the day off with a walk along the Belmont Boardwalk.


Tobago Cays – Five small islets and a dozen reefs make up one of most beautiful anchorages in the Caribbean. Image anchoring in 10 feet of crystal-clear water behind the protective Horseshoe Reef while you watch sea turtles surface all around you. The other major reef here is called World's End Reef, because your next stop is Africa. Between two of the islets there is a protected beach that is very popular for beach BBQs hosted by various boat boys. 0

Efficient and Energy-Saving Cooking on Board

ur SY Pitufa came with an old-fashioned kerosenestove. We never got the oven to work properly, adjusting the temperature remained a mystery and it heated up the boat unbearably. The stove theoretically features three cooktops, but when we tried to run two simultaneously the pressure in the kerosene line dropped to a spluttering, orange flame. We toyed with the idea of throwing the soot-spitting monster over board more than once, but in the



end we learned to live with our "Bertschie" and made a virtue out of necessity: nowadays I cook multi-course meals on just one burner—efficient and without using much energy. Don't get me wrong, I wouldn't advise anybody to install a kerosene stove, but the tricks that I've acquired over the years also work with regular gas stoves or electric systems.

Steaming instead of boiling

I don't have a special steamer, I simply put a metal sieve on the bottom of the pot, so I only need to fill in half an inch of water. Veg is placed on top of the grid and gently steamed (thus keeping the vitamins alive) instead of boiled to death. With this

Super-Simple Pan Bread

2 cups of wheat flour

1 cup of rye flour

1,5 cups warm water

1 teaspoon dried yeast

1 teaspoon salt

bread spices

(typical Austrian: ground coriander, ground caraway, fennel)

Mix dry ingredients in a bowl, add water, stir well with a spoon (no kneading necessary).

Pour the dough into an oiled pan (with a lid). Let it rise for 1 hour then put the pan on the stove on a small flame and 'bake' the bread for 20 minutes with the lid closed. Flip it and bake another 15 minutes with a small gap in the lid.





method the stove only needs the energy to get a cup of water to the boiling point instead of heating several liters.

Lid on

Sure, some dishes have to be fried crispy and then the pan has to stay open. In all other cases putting a lid on keeps whatever's cooking hot and the boat cool. You can use a smaller flame with the lid on and the cooking time is reduced considerably.

Put aside to steep

A single-hander changed my relationship with rice forever with a simple tip: it's enough to boil rice for a short time, then it can be set aside. Simply sweat the rice with some butter (in our case one cup for two people), add water according to instructions on the packet (usually 1:2, sometimes 1:1.75 or 1:1.5), bring to boil (with the lid on) and let boil for about one minute, then set the pot aside and cover it well with a towel. After about 10 minutes all water is absorbed and the rice done. This method means for me that I can prepare a wok or curry or two on my one functioning burner, while the rice

quietly finishes preparing itself. When I'm done with the main meal, the rice is ready to be served as well!

At some point I discovered that pasta can be cooked similarly: for spaghetti, tagliatelle and their colleagues I bring water to boil, add the pasta, but I only cook it for about half the time that is suggested on the package and put the pot aside. While the pasta sauce is simmering, I occasionally try a noodle and when they have reached the desired stage of "al dente" I strain them.

Baking on the stove

Even though I haven't used our oven in 10 years, I still bake bread every other day and we frequently have classic oven-dishes like lasagna, pies, pizza or cakes. I simply use a sturdy, non-stick pan on the stove top to "bake" in. Dishes au gratin are gently simmered with a lid on, bread and cakes have to be flipped after half the baking-time is done—that involves some action and adrenaline, but usually works out well (and if not I hide the broken cake-pieces underneath a layer of frosting, chocolate and cream)!

Pan-Pie

As I usually don't find all ingredients for recipes in the minimarkets in the middle of nowhere, I tend to substitute and simplify. Here's a very flexible recipe for a delicious desert (or starter):

FOR THE FILLING:

Peel and slice 2 mangos or half a papaya, or collect/buy a cup of raspberries or other berries or drain a can of fruit 1 cup of kefir, or yoghurt or cream cheese

3 eggs

3 tbsp corn flour or corn starch 4 tbsp sugar

FOR THE CASE:

1/2 cup of almond flour or oats or breadcrumbs

Grease a non-stick pan generously with butter and sprinkle in the crumbly base. Pour the filling on top and add the fruit. Put a lid on the pan and "bake" the tarte on a very small flame for 10 minutes

while shifting the pan every two minutes slightly (it burns easily).

Turn off the stove and leave the pie with the lid on for another 5 to 10 minutes. Serve the pieces warm with some icing sugar sprinkled on!

TIP: if you don't add sugar to the filling and replace the fruit with veg (e.g. pre-steamed broccholi and blue cheese or heart of palm pieces and parmesan you can turn the recipe into a gratin!

Women on the Water -Lisa Roland & Nini Champion, Team Ocean Grown

rossing the great blue gauntlet of the Atlantic Ocean by sail is a bucket list challenge and triumph for ✓ many. But for Nini Champion and Lisa Roland, this feat is a been-there, done-that not once, but several times. In fact, the 30- and 31-year-old professional sailors together have 60,000 nautical miles under their belts. Now, they are ready to challenge themselves in a new way. In December, Champion and Roland as Team Ocean Grown will be one

of 13 pairs teams to depart from La Gomera, in the Canary Islands, in the Talisker Whisky Atlantic Challenge, rowing their way 3000 miles transatlantic to Nelson's Dockyard, in Antiqua. The duo is not the first. The four-women Team Antigua Island Girls became the first all-female Caribbean team to complete this epic row in 2019. Four-men teams before them, Team Antiqua in 2018 and Team Wadadli in 2015, completed the challenge too. But for 2023, the next line in the sand is a two-woman Caribbean-based team.

Why?

"We have both been so privileged to spend time working and living in Antiqua, the iconic sailing destination which also serves as the finish line for the race. Each year, the community welcomes the rowers as they complete this incredible challenge, and for both of us, a seed was planted. As sailors, crossing an ocean by the power of wind is such a remarkable feat. The thought of crossing by your own strength, while intimidating and terrifying, is an exceptional new challenge. We each have our reasons for deciding to come together, but the strength to rise to such a challenge, the perseverance required to get to the start line, and the cooperation, determination, and raw endurance required to row an ocean was intoxicating. It was over a dinner with friends in February 2019 where we first discussed our mutual desire to race, and in November of 2020, Team Ocean Grown was born," explains Champion.

A Wealth of On the Water Experience


Champion, a professional rigger, and Roland, a licensed captain, have nearly life-long personal and professional experience on the sea.

Champion grew up in Annapolis, MD, and did deliveries from here to the U.S. and British Virgin Islands, as well as her first transatlantic from Annapolis to Portugal by way of Bermuda and the Azores, with her family. For the last five years, she has worked as a professional sailor in positions such as a first mate, a rigging technician, and last summer as a rotational captain in Denmark. Earlier this year, Champion crewed aboard Antigua's Bernie Wong's RP 37, Taz, in the RORC 600.

Canadian-born Roland grew up sailing dinghies such as Sunfish, Optis and Lasers. She started her career at 19, working on the 75-foot wooden ketch, Mar II, as a day sailor out of Halifax. In her career, Roland has worked on tall ships, sport fishing vessels, and sailing yachts. She served as a successful captain for Dream Yacht Charters in locations across the globe. This led to jobs on private, inter-











nationally run yachts, including a transatlantic voyage from Antigua to Palma six years ago. Then, she was recruited back as a base manager for Dream Yacht at its St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands location. Roland also does a substantial amount of work in the superyacht industry on topics of diversity and inclusion. She's delivered keynote addresses to industry leaders on the topic.

The Row

Teams in the Talisker Whisky Atlantic Challenge row transatlantic in a self-contained, self-sufficient rowboat. The Rannoch Adventure R25 is a two-person design with two rowing positions and two berths in its 24-foot of length and 5.5-foot beam. Teams row two hours on, two hours off, 24 hours a day from start to finish. Last year, a British duo set the record for two-women teams at 45 days, 7 hours and 25 minutes. Champion and Roland have based their vessel in St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, where they are training. Preparing for the challenge has also included seeking out tips from other successful women rowers.

"One of the most valuable tips we've received was from the woman last year who set the fastest solo record to date for this race. She told us to be sure to eat. We'll be provisioned with freeze-dried snack meals, but she warned us there is a huge temptation at the end of a two-hour shift to just curl up and sleep rather than trying to heat up and eat a meal in the rolling swell. But it's important to stay fueled and hydrated," says Champion.

On average, rowers lose 25 pounds during the 1.5 million oar strokes it takes to cross the Atlantic.

The Give Back

Beyond the incredible challenge and self-building aspect of the Talisker Whiskey Atlantic Challenge, teams are encouraged to choose and raise funds for a cause important to them. For Champion and Roland, this is their Bridges over Water grant fund. The fund will finance young adults who have aged out of the foster care system to gain entry to and pursue careers in the maritime industry. It's a topic near and









purchasing jug handles of other people's rum when he could make his own. Soon he found himself attending the Miami Renaissance Festival in 2016, with "nurses" serving his rum from syringes and handing out vanilla ice cream with a squirt of rum on top. The Doc Brown Really Bad Rum brand was born.

The rum is proudly Made in the USA, using "exquisitely fine dark rum"; however, it's not disclosed where this rum is from. We know they are infusing the dark rum with "natural flavors and caramel color." That may be why Terry enjoyed this rum a little too much.

HE SAID

There is an alcohol burn when bringing the glass to my nose, but it guickly gives way to apricot with subtle hints of nutmeg and oak. The liquid is thick and rich, satisfyingly coating my entire palate. The apricot is still front and center with some added sweetness, possibly from molasses. The nutmeg helps break the sweetness on the palate and carries the rum to a unique finish. The rum almost fizzes on the back of my tongue, then finishes with nutmeg and oak. I love the lingering of this finish. It allows me to take my time before another sip. Should I cut it with a bit of water, like bourbon, to thin out the syrupiness on the palate?

SHE SAID

Dark Rum? Well, it's more golden with a touch of amber. The rum coats the glass nicely, with long, slow legs dripping down the glass. A sweet aroma wafts from the glass as it sits on the table; however, that sweetness is not as intense on the nose. The smell takes me immediately to a pina colada with pineapple, coconut, and nutmeg sprinkled on the top. The rum is smooth, and I want to keep sipping and sipping like a cocktail. I'm not having the same finish experience as Clint, although the nutmeg stays with me from sip to sip.

OVERALL

You can tell that the producer cared about your experience with Doc Brown Really Bad Rum Co. Dark. The rum is sweeter than Clint typically likes but has some character to find if your palate allows it. At \$30/bottle, it's worth having in your cabinet for the beginner to intermediate rum connoisseur.

Quick and Easy Light Summer Meals

CARIBBEAN COOKING | BY CAP'N JAN ROBINSON

Here are a few recipes that are not only quick and easy, but nutritious and perfect for lunch or dinner.

AHI TUNA POKE BOWL

Prep time: 15 minutes. Cooking time: 15 minutes. Serves: 4

1 lb. *Ahi Tuna or yellowfin, cut in 1/2-inch cubes 1 tsp. fresh grated ginger 2 cloves fresh garlic, minced 1/4 cup soy sauce, low sodium or Tamari 1 tsp. rice vinegar 34 tsp. red pepper flakes, crushed

GARNISH: Crispy wontons

1-1/2 tsp. Sesame oil ½ cup green onions, thinly sliced 1/2 tsp. sesame seeds Jalapeno pepper sliced 2 cups brown rice or white rice, cooked 2 cups salad greens or Asian slaw

In a medium size bowl combine ahi tuna, ginger, garlic, soy sauce, rice vinegar, sesame, oil red pepper flakes, green onions, jalapeno, and sesame seeds. Place cooked rice, salad, tuna, and desired toppings decoratively in each bowl. Serve immediately or refrigerate covered for up to 2 hours. NOTE: * check that the tuna is sushi-grade and safe to eat raw.

HINT: There are numerous ways to customize the poke bowl ingredients. Just be creative and add anything fresh - salad greens, avocado, grated carrots, edamame beans, cubed cucumbers, etc.

SEARED SNAPPER WITH SNOW PEA SALAD

Prep time: 15 minutes. Cooking time: 10 minutes. Serves: 4 SNOW PEA SALAD:

1 lemon rind, finely grated, and juiced

2 Tbsp. finely chopped shallots 3 Tbsp extra virgin olive oil Salt and pepper, to taste

6 oz snow peas, thinly sliced lengthwise

2 oz of arugula 5 radishes, thinly sliced 1 cup fresh basil leaves, sliced 1 cup fresh mint leaves, sliced 1 cup walnuts, chopped Lemon wedges

GARNISH: 1 oz. piece parmesan cheese, finely grated

2 (12 oz) filets of Snapper, halved with skin-on 1 Tbsp. extra virgin olive oil

In a large bowl whisk lemon rind, 2 Tbsp. lemon juice shallots and 3 Tbsp. oil Season with salt and pepper. Toss with snow peas, arugula, radishes, basil, mint and walnuts.

Heat a large heavy-based pan over medium-high heat. Add 1 Tbsp olive oil to pan. With a cloth, pat snapper filets completely dry and season all over with salt. Place skin-side down in pan. Cook, pressing down on filets for the first couple of minutes. Cook a couple more minutes or until skin is crisp and golden brown. Turn snapper filets over and cook for about 2 minutes more. Divide among serving plates, skin side up. Place snow pea salad alongside snapper. Sprinkle with cheese and serve with lemon wedges.

ONE PAN ROASTED SHRIMP AND ASPARAGUS

Prep time: 10 minutes. Cooking time: 10 minutes. Serves: 4

2 bunches asparagus, woody ends removed 3 Tbsp. extra virgin olive oil, divided 2 oz. finely grated parmesan

20 large shrimp, peeled, leaving tails intact **GARNISH: Lemon wedges** 4 cloves garlic, peeled and finely chopped 1 tsp. smoked paprika 1/4 tsp. dried red chili flakes Salt and pepper, to taste 1 Tbsp. finely chopped parsley

Preheat oven to 450°F. On a flat baking tray, toss asparagus with 1 Tbsp. oil. Arrange in one even row over half the tray. Sprinkle most of the parmesan evenly over asparagus. Pat shrimp dry with a paper towel. In a medium size bowl, toss shrimp with garlic, paprika, chili flakes, and 2 Tbsp. oil, salt, and pepper. Spread the shrimp evenly over the other side of baking tray. Roast for 10 minutes or until shrimp have cooked (turned pink) and asparagus is tender. Sprinkle shrimp with chopped parsley and sprinkle asparagus with remaining cheese. Serve with lemon wedges.
